DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Meredith Wilson may not be a household name like Rogers and Hammerstein or Andrew Lloyd Webber, but his classic musical "The Music Man" has become one of the most legendary pieces in the history of the Broadway Stage. Long before the lyrics of "Hamilton" were being rapped along The Great White Way, Professor Harold Hill was doing the same thing for the mothers of River City with the immortal "patter" song "Trouble."

Based on his childhood experiences in Mason City, Iowa, "The Music Man" holds distinctions of winning the first Grammy Award presented for Best Musical Theatre Album, beating out "West Side Story" for the Tony Award for best musical of 1957, and being the 68th longest running Broadway show beating out such powerhouses as "The King and I", "Annie Get Your Gun," and "Guys and Dolls."

We are delighted to share this time honored classic with all of you. We dedicate this show to all of our wonderful patrons at Heritage Theatre who secretly march to "76 Trombones" or still wonder if you can sing the tenor part of a barbershop quartet. Thank you for coming to our theatre and enjoy the show.

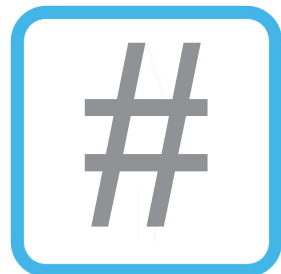

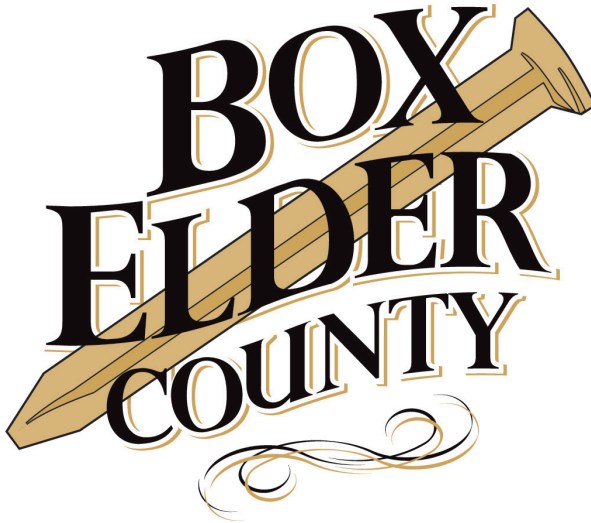

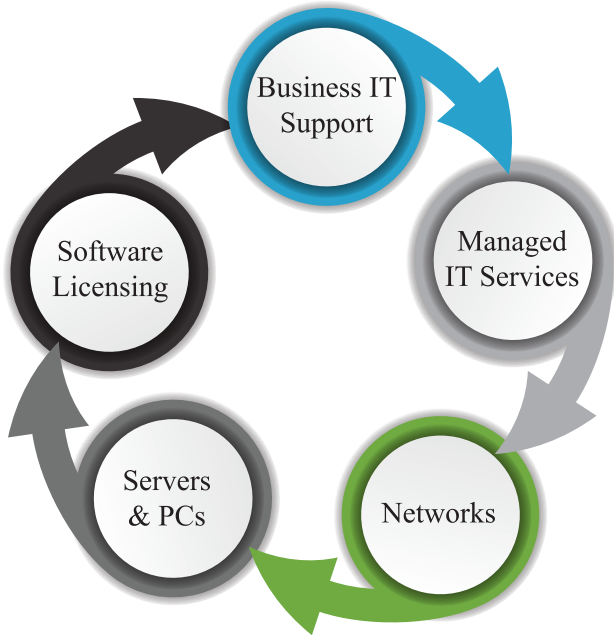
